It is your responsibility to make sure your transcripts and letters of recommendation are sent.

Please include the following:

- Completed application form
- Official transcript from your school mailed directly to the Ruby Holland Foundation
- Parent (s) W-2 and /or FAFSA
- A brief biography including career goals
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers and/or employers familiar with your abilities and work habits. (These letters should contain the complete name, address, and telephone number of the writer and should be mailed directly to the above address.)
- One recent photograph of yourself for our file

The following criteria will be used in awarding the grants:

- Academic record
- Financial need
- United States citizenship and attend a U.S. college or university
- Resident of Orange or Seminole county
- Community service and /or work record
- Other scholarships for which you applied

If you are a finalist, you will be notified and asked to provide a 3-minute video to be emailed to the committee. You will be notified if a video is required along with questions to be answered on the video.
